HISTORY

Alliant International University was founded in 2001 through the combination of United States International University (USIU) and California School of Professional Psychology/Alliant University (CSPP/AU). USIU was founded in 1952 as California Western University. CSPP/AU was founded in 1969. San Francisco Law School has been in operation since 1906 and merged with Alliant International University on July 1, 2010.

Alliant International University's Marital and Family Therapy programs have been accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Marriage and Family Therapy (COAMFTE) of the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy (AAMFT) since July 2001. San Francisco Law School has been continuously accredited by the Committee of Bar Examiners of the State of California since 1937 and became accredited by the Accrediting Commission for WASC through the merger with Alliant International University on July 1, 2010.

All credential and designated certification and authorization programs offered by the Alliant California School of Education are California Commission on Teacher Credentialing approved professional preparation programs.

Alliant International University is approved to operate by the California Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education. Approval to operate means the institution is compliant with the minimum standards contained in the California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009 and the California Code of Regulations.

- 800-999: Courses designed for the last two years of standard program; available to first and second year students only under special circumstances.

2002 - Present (Alliant International University)

- 0999-4999: Undergraduate Courses
- 5000-5999: Prerequisite courses for masters and doctoral programs. Courses for teaching credential candidates (up to Fall 2004).
- 6000-9999: Graduate level courses open to holders of a baccalaureate degree subject to prerequisite or other requirements as stated in program or course descriptions.
