Applicants to CSPP graduate programs may be eligible to receive credit for previous graduate work, at the discretion of the program to which they are admitted. These credits must have been completed with a grade of B or better from an accredited institution within the past seven years. A maximum of 30 units of graduate coursework and no more than 25% of a doctoral program’s total unit requirement may be accepted. Although credit for previous graduate work may reduce the total number of units for which a student needs to enroll in the program, it rarely reduces the time to completion due to practicum requirements and other course sequences. Graduates of the clinical psychology program hold a variety of professional career positions across the country and in a few countries outside the U.S. as well. Some of these positions do not require licensure as a psychologist, particularly those in academic settings, government, and research. Therefore, some graduates do not seek licensure as a psychologist during their professional careers. It typically takes graduates two years post graduation to complete the requirements to become a licensed psychologist.
