This disclosure is provided in compliance with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts regulations requiring all proprietary schools to provide the following disclosures to Massachusetts consumers or prospective students.

### **COST OF PROGRAM**

The program costs listed below is reflective of the 2025-2026 tuition rates. Tuition rates are set by the Board of Trustees and typically increase each year; therefore, the actual cost of the program may be higher than the estimated total due for the entire program listed on this agreement. The program cost listed in this agreement is for full-time enrollment and assumes completion based on the Master Plan of Study. The total cost of the program may vary and be higher, based on my schedule, full-time or part-time enrollment status, transfer credit, failure of courses, approval delays or changes in practicum, internships or clinical placements, delays in accruing the required hours of experience once placed, if I choose to take courses beyond the basic program curriculum, and/or other similar circumstances.

For doctoral students completing dissertations - Failure to complete the dissertation as scheduled will require enrollment in dissertation continuation courses which will increase the total cost of the program. Note that financial aid may be limited or not available for dissertation extension courses.

The program cost includes the estimated cost of books and supplies.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts’ definition of “Graduation Time” is calculated as the duration of attendance in months, rounded to the nearest month, of all students who obtained a certificate, diploma, or degree from a program during the latest two calendar years.

**YOUR LOAN DEBT**

**LOAN NONPAYMENT STATISTICS**

Alliant International University’s most recent federal cohort default rate is 0.0% for FY24. However, under Massachusetts regulation 940 CMR 31.03 Loan Nonpayment Percentage is the sum of the most recent cohort default rate plus the percentage of borrowers, not including those calculated into the federal cohort default rate, whose Stafford loans were in deferment or forbearance. As defined by the Massachusetts regulations, 100% of Alliant students had their loans during the period FY19 placed into a forbearance status as result of the COVID-19 relief efforts by the federal government.

**PLACEMENT RATES AND EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS**

Massachusetts’ regulations require schools offering occupational programs to disclose the number of graduates in the last 2 calendar years who have secured obtained full-time, non-temporary jobs in their field of study. However, Alliant’s accreditor, WASC Senior College and University Commission, does not require us to track this data and we are not required to maintain employment statistics as a condition of receiving, or continuing to receive, said state or federal financing.

As a requirement of the California Bureau for Private Postsecondary education, Alliant does prepare School Performance Fact Sheets for all programs being offered.
