



Retention Rate of Degree or Credential Seeking Students – Fall 2022

Information on entering student **one-year retention** is provided to prospective and enrolled students in compliance with the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008. Retained students are those students who remain enrolled at Alliant one year after entry either in their original program or a new program plus students who completed their educational degree or program within that year.

These data are for those who first enrolled for Fall 2022 in the August semester or term 2022. Most Alliant undergraduate degree-seeking students are transfer students. *New students do not include those who were previously enrolled in or transferred from similar Alliant programs in the prior year.*
